The Carte d'Or Cuvée is every expression of the Drappier with its very high proportion of Pinot Noir, one is almost tasting a Blanc de Noirs. A Champagne with a fine aromatic richness, it opens with aromas of stoned fruits such as white vineyard peach. 125ml £8.95

Drappier Blanc de Blancs £55.00
The nose brings to mind white peach & pear but also more floral notes such as peony. On the palate a mineral Champagne lightly biscuit. Creamy, supple, seductive. Made exclusively from white grapes, as the name may suggest.

Drappier Brut Rosé £55.00
Very well structured, with exemplary purity of red fruits. A striking Champagne on the nose offering similar sensations on the palate. Warm & satiny, lightly spiced with balanced hints of stone fruits, leading to a lovely freshness on the finish.

Drappier Brut Sans Soufre £59.50
Very fresh notes evoking pear, lemon & hazlenuts. On the palate a very dry & mineral Champagne but bursting with life. It will delight enthusiasts & purists on the lookout for new taste bud sensations. Reccommended for those allergic to sulphur.

Drappier Millesime Exception, 2006 £69.50
A very complex, rich nose comprising hints of citrus fruits, bread hazlenuts & almond. A touch of vanilla testifies to the high proportion of Chardonnay while the depth of the Pinot Noir is expressed in the form of red fruits & violets.

Drappier Grand Sendrée 2005 £89.50
Golden in colour with amber nuances. The Grande Sendrée reveals subtle aromas of dried fruits & some touches of toast. The whole unfolding into notes of citrus fruits, fruits with white flesh & stoned fruits. The palate accentuates the vinosity, the depth & the structure.

array of aromatic qualities,
which vary according to
growing location and its
treatment in the cellar.

From the Loire Valley
the style is reminiscent
of cut-grass, gooseberry,
flint & nettles.

In the New world,
particularly New Zealand
it produces a stunning
array of pungently assertive
characters, from the
green grass, green bean,
tinned pea & asparagus
flavours to the more
tropical, ripe spectrum
of grapefruit, guava,
passion fruit & mango.

~ Chardonnay ~

The most popular of all white grape varieties! As the grape of white burgundy it produces a variety of flavours, from mineral unoaked Chablis, to complex, nutty dry whites of Meursault,

Chassagne & Puligny. In the New World, and warmer climes of Europe it produces opulently & exotically flavoured whites.

Chardonnay varies from the melon, apple & grapefruit cool climate styles to more tropical fruit styles with flavours of peach, mango lime & pineapple.

~ Viognier ~

The hottest of the Rhône Valley trio, which includes Marsanne & Roussanne. From the small appellation of Condrieu, considered to produce some of the greatest whites, it is aromatic, powerful, with its hallmark blossom scents & apricot & peach-like flavours.

In the new world you get apricot & peach & can become exotic & spicy with plenty of body. It is planted throughout the New World, in particular Argentina.

~ Mersault Vieilles Vignes ~

The vines are around the village of Meursault in the South of the Côte de Beaune.

100% Chardonnay, primarily in a style with a clear oak influence, which have led to descriptions, such as buttery, to be applied to powerful examples of Meursault wines.

~ Tignanello ~

Piero Antinori was the owner of a very old winery in the Chianti Classico region. His Tignanello, the first of its kind in 1971.

The Tignanello had no addition of white grapes and was based almost entirely on the Sangiovese and was aged in barriques (later on the Cabernet Sauvignon was added).

~ Champagne ~

Champagne is a sparkling wine produced from the Champagne region grape grown in France following rules that demand, among other things, secondary fermentation of the wine in the bottle to create carbonation, specific vineyard practices, sourcing of grapes exclusively from specific parcels in the Champagne appellation & specific pressing regimes unique to the region.

It is illegal to officially label any product Champagne unless it both comes from the Champagne region.

~ Merlot ~

For long considered the junior partner in the great Bordeaux duo of grape varieties, it has more recently almost achieved 'cult status' thanks to certain Merlot based Pomerols & Saint Emilions in Bordeaux, as well as its lusciously plummy styles from California & Chile.

It's soft textured producing plummy fruit & almost fruit cake flavours & mellow tannins.

From the cooler climates you might get a little grass & bell pepper as it develops blackcurrant, blackberry, blueberry chocolate & spice characteristics when fully ripe.

~ Pinotage ~

Pinotage is South Africa's very own grape variety, a cross between Pinot Noir & Cinsault. However watch out Pinot Noir lovers, just because it is made with Pinot Noir doesn't mean it tastes the same. Now being planted in numerous other countries in the New World.

Pinotage offers juicy raspberry to blueberry fruit flavours. Rich plummy with spiced chocolate & tobacco. Often those from South Africa will exhibit a certain 'rubber' or slightly 'burnt rubber' characteristic.

~ Malbec ~
Responsible for the so-called 'black wine of Cahors' in South-west France, Malbec is also a minor partner among the five main red varieties that make up the Bordeaux blend.
In France it can be harsh & rustically tannic. However it is the red grape par excellence in Argentina, where it makes a softer, juicier style of red, with raspberry, mulberry blackberry allied to tar & game-like undertones. We are also seeing Malbec in Chile, Australia & California.

~ Cabernet Sauvignon ~
Cabernet Sauvignon makes the most dependable candidate for aging, more often improving into a truly great wine than any other single varietal. With age, its distinctive black currant aroma can develop bouquet nuances of cedar, violets, leather, or cigar box and its typically tannic edge may soften and smooth considerably.

Soft, delicate notes of pink grapefruit & strawberry woven together with a lovely minerality & freshness. Beautiful colour, the palest of pale roses, fragrance of clean fresh fruit.

~ Rosé Wine ~
When rosé wine is the primary product, it is produced with the skin contact method. Black-skinned grapes are crushed and the skins are allowed to remain in contact with the juice for a short period, typically one to three days. The must is then pressed, & the skins are discarded rather than left in contact throughout fermentation (as with red wine making). The longer that the skins are left in contact with the juice, the more intense the color of the final wine.

~ Dessert Wine ~
There is no simple definition of a dessert wine. In the UK, a dessert wine is considered to be any sweet wine drunk with a meal, as opposed to the white fortified wines (fino and amontillado sherry) drunk before a meal, and the red fortified wines (port and madeira) drunk after it.
Most fortified wines are regarded as distinct from dessert wines, but some of the less strong fortified white wines, such as Pedro Ximénez sherry and Muscat de Beaumes-de-Venise, are regarded as honorary dessert wines.
